**Updated Caps for 2007 – 2008 Amherst/Lorain Area Dart League Seasons (Fall & Winter)**

**Gold Division**

1. Only 2 Gold Players allowed on the roster. The total PPD (points-per-dart) of the 2 Gold players must not exceed 63 points.
2. The total combined PPD of the other 2 Players on the roster must not exceed 52 points.
3. Team cap is 115 points.

**Silver Division**

1. Player cap is 24.5 PPD.
2. Team cap is 98 points.

**Bronze Division**

1. Player cap is 22.5 PPD.
2. Team cap is 88 points.

**Copper Division**

1. Player cap is 18.5 PPD.
2. Team cap is 72 points

All players must roster at or below the player cap for the division, with an allowable player PPD increase of 2 points. The team total must not, at any time, exceed the team cap for that division. If the team total exceeds the team cap at any time in the season, one of the following will apply:

1. The team will be bumped to the appropriate division for league, playoff, and/or tournament purposes.
2. The player with the increased PPD will not be allowed to continue play with the team. (Note: Any player with a 27.0 or higher PPD will be considered a Gold player for rostering purposes.)

Players joining Lorain Music Leagues from another league will have their marks (PPD & MPR) from that league taken into consideration, if available.

All new players without an established PPD will enter their division at a default PPD number equal to 2 points less than the player cap for that division. The default PPDs are as follows:

- Gold Division – 26.5
- Silver Division – 22.5
- Bronze Division – 20.5
- Copper Division – 16.5

After 2 weeks of playing, their PPD mark will revert to the mark the player has established.

**Forfeits**

If your team receives a forfeit, you must enter that at the board and pay your fees. If this is done, you will receive 75% of the total games played per division as a forfeit. The numbers of games a team will receive in a forfeit are as follows:

- Gold Division – 16
- Silver Division – 16
- Bronze Division – 14
- Copper Division – 11

(Note: If you do not pay for your forfeit, you will not receive your team's forfeit games and the amount owed will be deducted from your team's final payout.)

**Rule Change**

If a team allows a player to throw for them under a name that is not their own, the opposing team may protest the outcome of the match. If the protest is upheld, the offending team will forfeit all wins for the entire match.
